Thanks to the support of Tulsa voters and funding from the 2015 bond, students and teachers at Street School will begin the 2021-2022 school year in a building with newly renovated spaces to learn and grow.

The 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools will further enhance the school's campus by:

- » Remodeling the school's STEM lab;
- » Resurfacing the parking lot and installing new lighting; and
- » Funding the purchase of a new digital marquee.

TOTAL INVESTMENT IN STREET SCHOOL: \$858,044

PROPOSITION 1: SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS - \$189,188

- » Fire and security alarms
- » Security cameras and radios
- » Safe entry and door access control
- » Parking lot, sidewalk, and exterior LED lighting
- » School and classroom furniture
- » Air quality/HVAC replacements - federally funded by the CARES Act

PROPOSITION 2: STUDENT AND CLASSROOM TECHNOLOGY - \$306,780

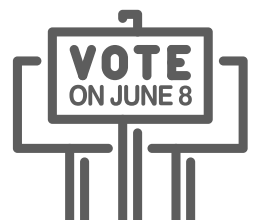
- » Network and systems upgrades

PROPOSITION 4: QUALITY LEARNING MATERIALS AND PROGRAMS - \$362,076

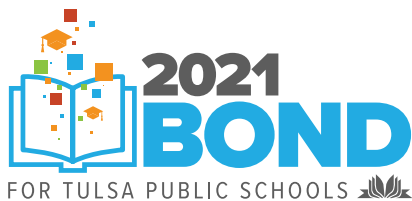
- » Textbooks and learning materials

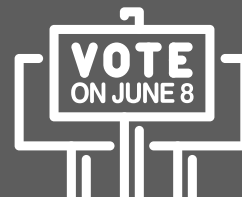


Project totals are estimates and will be adjusted to ensure projects are completed. Totals based on pupil count will be adjusted to reflect current enrollment.

The 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools is a \$414 million investment in Tulsa children, teachers, and families that will make an impact in **every** school:
